Katie Dell Kaufman

Katie Dell Kaufman will be giving a presentation on Collage at the April 11 LAG meeting. This presentation will be informative from a historical point of view, and a technical point of view. A slide show will be presented on the history of collage and then Katie will demonstrate and discuss various methods of altering papers; the use of altered papers in collage; the various adhesives and substrates used for collage construction; and image transfers.

Katie Kaufman has been exhibiting her work in the Washington, D.C. area since 1993. She is currently represented in the Fraser Gallery in Washington, D.C. and the Artec Gallery in Cumberland, MD. In addition, she does solo shows in New York, Maryland, and Virginia as well as group shows. She has been on the part-time faculty of the Corcoran Gallery of Art since 1989. She has been commissioned for large public works projects in the U.S. and in the UK.

Katie Dell Kaufman received her graduate degree from the University of Maryland, College Park and undergraduate degree in sculpture from Annandale-on-Hudson in New York.
