Susan Levi-Goerlich paints with a sewing machine. Of her stitched works of art she says, “Using my 30 year-old sewing machine as a noisy paintbrush, I blend and mix colors by layering threads. Painterly effects are created by thousands of stitches. Texture is achieved by determining the movement of the fabric under the needle.”



She also “paints” collages and landscapes using various types of fabrics. Susan has participated in numerous group and single shows throughout the area.
